Maintains and submits accurate and current reports and records involving student accountability, attendance, and performance. Improves professionally and maintains currency through maintaining certification as required; participating in professional and specialty courses; and keeping abreast of new developments, trends, and techniques. Develops and revises curriculum as needed. Performs other duties as assigned. This position will be assigned to the Federal Correctional facility located in Forrest City, AR. This is a grant funded position.

Current HVACR licensure, Certifications in EPA 608 Type 2 and CPR; experience as a trainer/instructor, 5 years of work experience as Residential Heat and Air Conditioning technician. A valid Arkansas Driver's License.
