

Welding Instructor (10 ½ Month)

East Arkansas Community College is accepting applications for the position of Welding Instructor (10 ½ Month schedule).

Position Summary:

The Welding Instructor reports directly to the Dean for Career and Technical Education and is a 10 ½ -month position. This position works within Career and Technical Education Division of EACC, and will provide high school instruction, college instruction, and customized training for industry partners in Welding.

This position is responsible for developing curriculum, assessment of institution/program/course learning objectives, and evaluating, coordinating and conducting industry training to suit customer needs. The duties of this position will be performed in support of the vision and mission of EACC. Additional duties and responsibilities include but are not limited to academic advising, service on college committees, maintaining class and training records, and holding scheduled office hours.

This position will also be involved in program planning, as well as student recruitment (secondary/postsecondary) and retention. Many of the activities associated with customized, training and local welding competitions, may occur on weekends or at varying times of the day.

Minimum Qualifications:

An Associate in Applied Science Degree in welding or a graduate of a certified trade school is preferred. Minimum requirement is 3 - 5 years progressive work experience in welding. Applicant must be a Certified Welding Inspector (CWI) or Certified Welding Educator (CWE) OR be willing to achieve certification within an agreed upon time.

Applicant should be thoroughly familiar with all aspects of welding with knowledge and skills in SMAW, MIG, Flux Core MIG, and TIG and must have knowledge of Gas and Plasma Cutting with abilities in Metal Fabrication. Applicant should have experience with SMAW, GTAW, GMA W, FCA W welding processes, and the ability to teach in other technical areas will be an asset to the applicant. The ideal candidate should have knowledge of electronic communications, basic computer concepts, program and course development, industry collaboration and partnerships, and certified welding inspector requirements.

Proof of practical skill is required.

Salary Range: \$43,333.00 annually (\$23.81/hr) - \$47,500.00 annually (\$26.10/hr), commensurate with education and experience.
