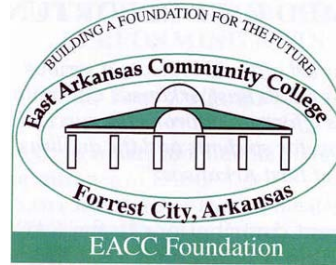

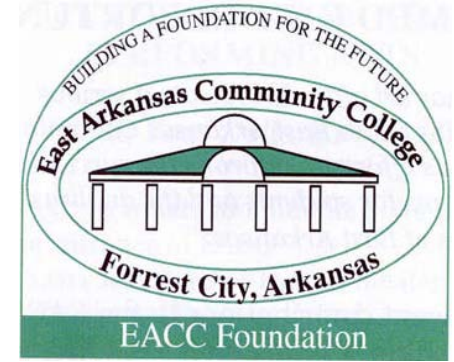

The Eleanor B. and Harry E. Beasley Scholarship

The family of Harry and Eleanor Beasley established this endowed scholarship in 2004 to keep alive the love of education their parents exhibited throughout their lives. Mr. Beasley was a farmer in east St. Francis County and a long-time member of the Hughes School Board. Mrs. Beasley spent 14 years on the East Arkansas Community College Board of Trustees after being elected in 1983 by the voters of St. Francis County.

The Beasley Endowed Scholarship is made possible through the generosity of their children: Dr. David Beasley, Thom Beasley, Harry G. Beasley, Nancy Beasley Lofton and Carolyn Jane Beasley Mason.

The Eleanor B. and Harry E. Beasley Scholarship is dedicated to assisting students at EACC who graduate from high schools located in St. Francis County. The award is \$500 per academic year to cover expenses of tuition, fees and books.

QUALIFICATIONS

- The student must have graduated from high school in St. Francis County
- Must be classified as a sophomore at EACC with at least 30 credit hours
- Must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student
- Must present 2 letters of recommendation from college instructors
- Must maintain a 3.0 GPA and full-time student status for second semester award

AWARD PROCEDURES

- The deadline for application is May 15
- The EACC Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee will review applications and select recipient(s) based on the qualifications above
- The scholarship award will be divided equally between fall and spring semesters
- The recipient will be notified prior to the beginning of the fall semester
- The recipient must be willing to participate in publicity and news releases
