Mallory Nimocks a 1977 graduate of Forrest City High School and Carla Morehead Nimocks a 1979 graduate of Grosse Pointe North High School, Michigan in conjunction with Nimocks Oil Company, are proud to offer The Nimocks Oil Company Concurrent-Enrollment Scholarship for area high school students. Both Mallory and Carla see East Arkansas Community College as a leader in providing educational opportunities of both an academic and cultural nature which positively enhances the quality of life in the region.

Through this scholarship, Nimocks Oil Company is dedicated to furthering the educational endeavors of those students in the EACC service area who attend Forrest City High School, Lee Senior High School, Brinkley High School, Wynne High School, Cross County High School, Palestine/Wheatley High School and Lee Academy. The NOC Scholarship is designed to offer high school students an opportunity to earn credit towards their high school graduation while earning college credit as well.

The scholarship may be applied to one course within the academic year of the application, including: Summer I or II terms, Fall or Spring (if funds are available) semesters. The award will pay for tuition and required building and technology fees for a 3 credit hour course.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Overall High School GPA of 3.0 or better. Students who have previously completed college courses must submit both a High School GPA and College GPA of 3.0 or better.
- Must submit one letter of recommendation from the high school counselor and a one page letter written by the student. Both should document evidence of the student's desire to pursue an education.
- Complete application signed by both student and parent/guardian
- Be approved by the qualifying high school's principal – see bottom portion of application

- For English or Mathematics concurrent credit, a score on the ACT of 19+ **or** a qualifying score on the Compass or Asset placement tests prior to enrolling in college courses.

The Compass or Asset placement tests are given on the EACC campus by appointment. Contact the EACC Counseling Center at 633-4480 ext. 302 to schedule an appointment.

AWARD PROCEDURES

- **Deadline** is May 15th for summer and fall semester courses and Dec. 1st for spring semester, if funds are available.
- The EACC Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee will review applications and select recipient(s) based on the qualifications above and on a first come first served basis.
- All applicants will receive notification of award outcome.
- The recipient must be willing to participate in publicity and news releases.

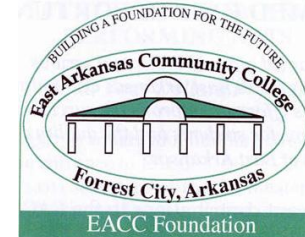
NIMOCKS OIL COMPANY CONCURRENT-ENROLLMENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Nimocks Oil Company Scholarship is available to individuals concurrently enrolled in high school and college courses, which may count towards both high school and college graduation requirements. To be entitled to this scholarship, the individual must meet college admission requirements for concurrently enrolled high school students and receive appropriate authorization from their high school principal and parent/legal guardian.

Nimocks Oil Company Scholarship students must remain enrolled in their high school, but they also have all the privileges and expectations of college students. They must comply with all East Arkansas Community College regulations and standards of conduct governing their enrollment as college students. If transportation, textbooks or other materials are needed for the college courses, the students or their high schools will be responsible for these provisions.

IMPORTANT: This form must be completed for each semester of enrollment in college courses and be returned to the high school counselor by May 15th for Summer I, II or Fall semesters and Dec. 1st for Spring semester (if funding is available). Approved scholarship applications and other required materials must be received by the East Arkansas Community College Development Office in its entirety before the application will be date stamped and given to the review committee for consideration.
