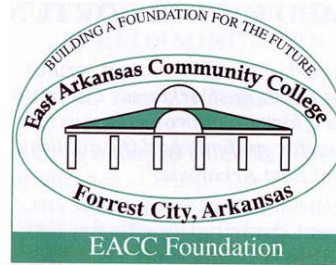

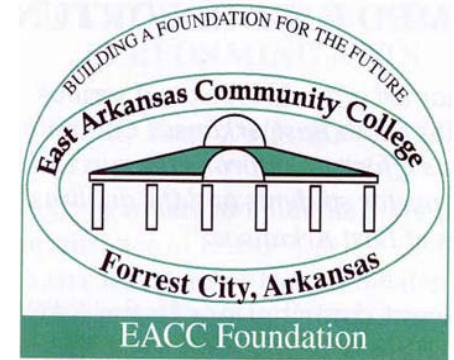

The Dr. Ben T. Whitfield Endowed Scholarship

The family of Dr. Ben T. Whitfield has established this endowed scholarship in 2006 to honor his memory and to show support for education which was such an important part of his life. Dr. Whitfield served as interim president at East Arkansas Community College from August 1998 to June 1999.

The Dr. Ben T. Whitfield Endowed Scholarship is made possible through the generosity of his wife, Mrs. Adell Whitfield.

The Dr. Ben T. Whitfield Endowed Scholarship is dedicated to assisting a first-time entering college student at EACC who plans to attend as a full-time student. The award is \$500 per academic year, based on availability of funds to cover expenses of tuition, fees, books and supplies.

QUALIFICATIONS

- The student must be a high school graduate
- Must be a first-time entering college student

- Must have a minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA on high school transcript

- Must be enrolled as a full-time student - minimum 12 hours per semester
- Must present 2 letters of recommendation - one from a high school instructor or counselor and one from a community member. Both should document evidence of student's desire to pursue an education.
- Must maintain a 2.5 GPA and full-time student status for second semester award

AWARD PROCEDURES

- The deadline for application is August 1st
- The EACC Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee will review applications and select recipient(s) based on the qualifications above
- The scholarship will be awarded at the beginning of the fall semester and renewed at the beginning of the spring semester if all criteria continues to be met
- The recipient will be notified prior to the beginning of the fall semester
- The recipient must be willing to participate in publicity and news releases
