Project Information

- 1. Building is approximately 33,000 Gross Square Feet.**
- 2. Theatrical Areas**
 - A. Stage**

The Stage is approximately 2900 SF, with a proscenium opening of 58 feet. The entire stage and proscenium area will have a sprung floor covered with Actor's Equity approved overlay mat.
 - B. Fly Loft**

Fly loft will be equipped to "fly" lights, curtains, and stage sets for Class A type productions.
 - C. Orchestra Pit**

The orchestra pit, located under the proscenium, will be a standard size and be the full width of the stage.
 - D. Equipment**

Facility will include dimming equipment, electrical service for traveling shows, communication systems, sound equipment and controls, and acoustic sound control.
 - E. Receiving**

The receiving area will be generous with truck dock access accommodating a variety of dock heights.
 - F. Back Stage Area**

This area includes women's and men's dressing rooms, a combined make-up area for men and women, a star dressing room with its own bath area, as well as other support spaces.
 - G. Black Box Theater**

This space is designed to handle small theater productions and will double as a rehearsal space.
- 3. Auditorium Area – 1100 Total Seats**
 - A. Fixed Seat Auditorium**

The fixed seat auditorium area will have 490 comfortable theater seats with a sloped floor to insure good sight lines.
 - B. Banquet/Exhibit Hall**

The Banquet/Exhibit Hall will have a level floor with telescoping comfortable bleacher seating for 610.
 - C. Catering Kitchen**

This area is for staging and warming food for events in the Banquet Hall.
- 4. Support Areas**
 - A. Lobbies**

A generous main lobby at the South entrance will be capable of handling large crowds. Smaller lobbies are located at the West and North entrances and exits.
 - B. Ticket Booth**
 - C. Art Gallery**

The art gallery is adjacent to the main lobby and will have ample, flexible space for the display of artwork including drawings, paintings, sculpture and other types of work.
 - D. Restrooms**

There will be adequate restroom facilities for the large crowds. Two sets of women's and men's restrooms are convenient located on each side of the auditorium space.
