- ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT: HAVE A GPA OF 2.75 OR BETTER.
- LEADERSHIP NOMINATION: BE NOMINATED BY THE PRESIDENT, A CHIEF ACADEMIC OFFICER, THE DIRECTOR OF RECRUITMENT, OR THE DEAN OF STUDENTS.
- HONORS PROGRAM: BE A PARTICIPANT IN THE HONORS PROGRAM.
- CLUB LEADERSHIP: BE AN OFFICER OF OTHER CAMPUS CLUBS/ORGANIZATIONS.
