The George and Alice Walker Endowed Scholarship was funded in 2004 though the estate of Mildred Sikes. Mrs. Sikes was the daughter of George and Alice Walker, both of whom preceded her in death.

Mrs. Walker was very active in the First United Methodist Church, serving for years as a Sunday school teacher. She was the first woman to serve on a grand jury in the state.

This scholarship is dedicated to the support of students at EACC pursuing an Associate of Applied Science degree in an allied health field. It was created because of the caring attention given family in their final days.
