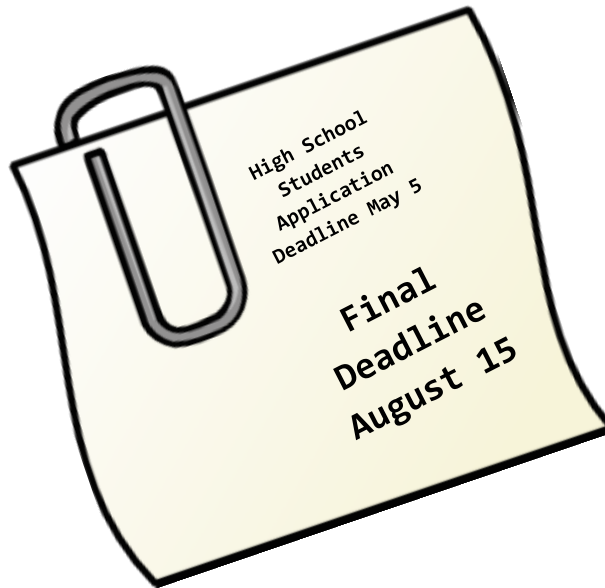

The Coy Grace School to Work Scholarship Application

The Coy Grace School to Work Scholarship is awarded to a student who has completed a program of study in the Eastark Secondary Career Center (ESCC) and/or to a student seeking a certificate or Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree.

This scholarship was established in December 2017 by the East Arkansas Community College Board of Trustees in honor of Dr. Coy Grace's 18 years of service as president of the college. This vocational scholarship will benefit students seeking a certificate or an AAS degree. Dr. Grace has a special affinity for technical education since his father, after returning from war, enrolled in an auto mechanics class at Navarro College in Grace's hometown of Corsicana, Texas. Dr. Grace said, "I realize the positive impact technical programs can have on individuals and their families."

The award is \$250 per semester or term based on availability of funds.

Must maintain full-time status and required GPA for continuation of scholarship.

Qualifications

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must:

- 1) Have completed a program of study in the Eastark Secondary Career Center (ESCC) and/or be seeking a certificate or an Associate of Applied Science degree.
- 2) Be enrolled as a full-time student at EACC seeking a certificate or Associate of Applied Science degree.
- 3) Have achieved a cumulative minimum 2.5 GPA.
- 4) Maintain a 2.5 GPA per semester or term.
- 5) Submit two (2) letters of recommendation from high school, GED, ESCC or EACC instructors.
- 6) Submit a one (1) page personal letter explaining why he/she feels qualified to receive this vocational scholarship.
