The Eleanor B. and Harry E. Beasley Scholarship

The family of Harry and Eleanor Beasley established this endowed scholarship in 2004 to keep alive the love of education their parents exhibited throughout their lives. Mr. Beasley was a farmer in east St. Francis County and a long-time member of the Hughes School Board. Mrs. Beasley spent 14 years on the East Arkansas Community College Board of Trustees after being elected in 1983 by the voters of St. Francis County.

The Beasley Endowed Scholarship is made possible through the generosity of their children: Dr. David Beasley, Thom Beasley, Harry G. Beasley, Nancy Beasley Lofton, and Carolyn Jane Beasley Mason.

The Eleanor B. and Harry E. Beasley Scholarship is dedicated to assisting students at EACC who graduate from high schools located in St. Francis

County. The award is \$250 per semester, based on availability of funds, to cover expenses of tuition, fees and books.

Qualifications

To be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must:

- 1) Have graduated from high school in St. Francis County.
- 2) Be classified as a sophomore at EACC with at least 30 college credit hours.
- 3) Have achieved and maintained a cumulative minimum 3.0 GPA.
- 4) Be enrolled as a full-time (at least 12 hours) student.
- 5) Submit 2 letters of recommendation from EACC instructors.
- 6) Submit a one (1) page personal letter explaining why he/she feels qualified to receive this scholarship.

Must maintain full-time status and required GPA for continuation of scholarship.
