

# George and Alice Walker Endowed Scholarship

The George and Alice Walker Endowed Scholarship was funded in 2004 though the estate of Mildred Sikes. Mrs. Sikes was the daughter of George and Alice Walker, both of whom preceded her in death.

The Walker family came to St. Francis County about 1900 and started a farming operation. George Walker continued that family business until his death. Mrs. Walker was very active in the First United Methodist Church, serving for years as a Sunday school teacher. She was the first woman to serve on a grand jury in the state.

This scholarship is dedicated to the support of students at EACC pursuing an Associate of Applied Science degree in an allied health field. It was created because of the caring attention given family in their final days. It is expected that these students will become practicing health care professionals and provide care for many others over their lifetimes.

This award is \$500 per semester, based on availability of funds, to cover expenses of tuition, fees, and books.
