QUALIFICATIONS:

- The applicant must be a graduate of a St. Francis County high school or attended a St. Francis County high school and subsequently received a GED; or the applicant may be a graduate of East Arkansas Community College.
- Must be a full-time college student, has completed at least 60 semester hours, and has at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
- Must provide a 300 word essay on "Why I Want to Teach".
- Must provide a letter of recommendation from one instructor in their major field.
- The recipient must maintain a GPA of at least 2.5.
- After graduation, the recipient is required to teach full-time in the Forrest City School District for a minimum of one year to receive full forgiveness of the scholarship/loan.
- Deadline for applying is May 31st.

AWARD PROCEDURES:

- The scholarship committee will meet to review the applications. A selection of the top two applicants will be made based on the guidelines for the scholarship criteria. The candidates will then be contacted for an interview.
- The committee will meet to select the scholarship recipient and will announce the winner on June 1st. The committee will contact the recipient and set a date for a press release and officially award the scholarship.
- The award amount is \$1,500 for an academic year.
