The Jarratt family is committed to the advancement of academic, economic, and cultural conditions and the general quality of life in eastern Arkansas. The Jarratt Family Scholarship Endowment Fund has been established to provide scholarships for the educational expenses for students attending East Arkansas Community College. One or more students may be selected according to the criteria. The Jarratt Family Scholarship Endowment Fund may

be used by the recipient for any educational expenses, but the maximum amount of the scholarship will be equal to the tuition and general fees charged all students in the year for which the scholarship is awarded which is approximately \$500 per semester. The student must maintain a 2.00 or higher GPA and complete a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester.



Qualifications:

In order to be eligible for consideration the applicant must:

- ◆ Have earned 24 credit hours;
- ◆ Be enrolled for and continue to pursue a degree as a full-time student;
- ◆ Have achieved and maintain a GPA of 2.00 or higher;
- ◆ Be a resident of a county where a branch or office of First National Bank of Eastern Arkansas is located;
- ◆ Have, in the opinion of the selection body, a true desire for an education and a true financial need, after considering financial aid received by the student from all other sources.

Selection Criteria:

The criteria for the selection of the student or students to whom the scholarships are awarded shall include, but not be limited to, considerations of the following:

- ◆ The student has sustained a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher;
- ◆ All financial aid received by the student will be considered and award will be given to the student with the greatest need.

- ◆ First generation college students, or students who have had an interruption in their education.

Award Procedures:

The deadline for applying for this scholarship is May 15th.

- ◆ The Financial Aid Scholarship Committee will meet to review and select the applicant based on the selection criteria.
- ◆ The scholarship will be awarded at the beginning of the fall semester and renewed for the spring semester if all criteria is met.
- ◆ The committee chair will notify the public relations office for a news release.
- ◆ The approximate award is up to \$1,000 for an academic year.
