

The Walter N. Moorehead, Sr. Memorial Scholarship

The Walter N. Moorehead, Sr. Memorial Scholarship was established in 2003 and is given by Mrs. Tempie Moorehead in honor of her husband. Mr. Walter N. Moorehead, Sr. was a long-time math and science educator in the Forrest City School District.

Many students fall just outside the Federal Title IV guidelines for Pell Grants and are unable to attend college. Even



with academic scholarships, students sometimes have difficulty paying all related tuition fees and textbooks. The Walter N. Moorehead Sr. Memorial Scholarship fund is an effort to help eliminate that barrier to higher education.

The Mooreheads were both graduates of the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff (UAPB). Mrs. Moorehead has chosen this method to assist others in achieving their educational goals. She believes in East Arkansas Community College and therefore, would like to offer financial assistance to a first-time entering student who plans to transfer to UAPB after completing a transfer degree at EACC.

The Walter N. Moorehead, Sr. Memorial Scholarship will primarily assist with tuition fees and textbooks for a maximum of



\$250.00 per semester to be awarded in the fall and spring. The recipient is expected to maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50.

Qualifications

- The student must have graduated from high school or have a GED.
- Must enroll full-time at EACC, and have a 2.50 cumulative GPA or composite score of 550 on the GED.
- The recipient must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50.
- Must provide a letter of recommendation from your counselor or principal.
- Must be seeking an Associate of Arts degree from EACC and transfer to the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff.
- Must have applied for a Pell Grant.
- Must demonstrate financial need.

Awards Procedures

- The deadline for applying for this scholarship is April 16th.
- The scholarship committee will meet to review and select the applicant based on the selection criteria.
- The scholarship recipient will be announced in May.
- The Committee Chair will schedule a press release for Mrs. Moorehead to award the scholarship.
- The maximum award is \$500.00 for an academic year.
