### Finding Books on History

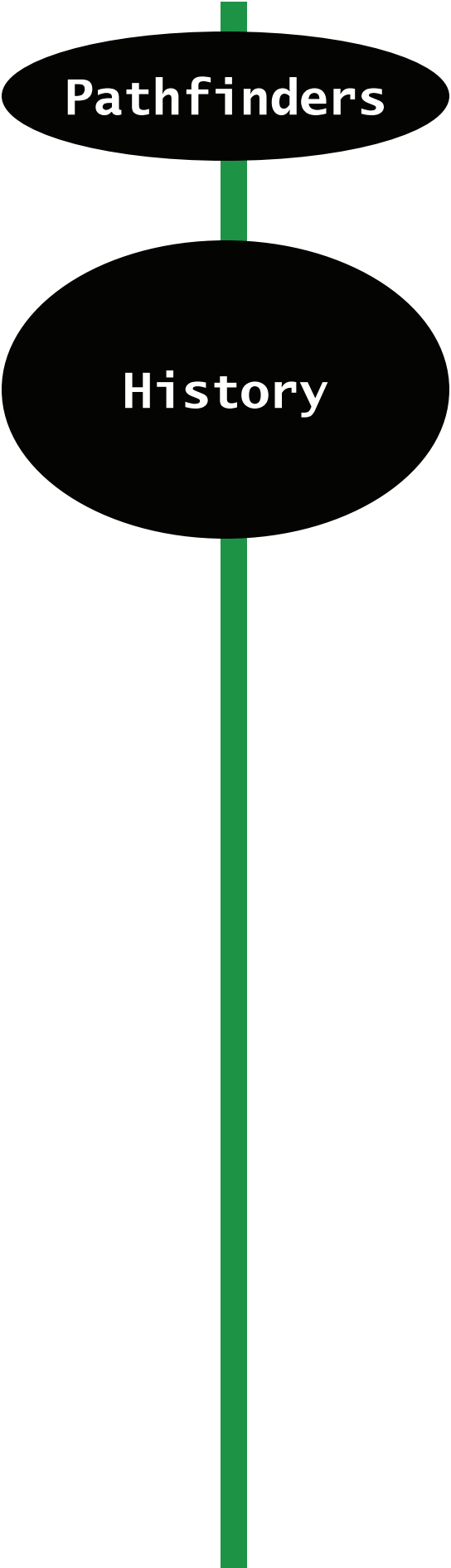
All books are arranged by subject using the Library of Congress classification for call numbers and subject headings. The call numbers for History is **D, E and F**. A more detailed listing of History is below:
