

## Criminal Justice Faculty Member Position

East Arkansas Community College is accepting applications for a full time, nine-month criminal justice faculty position. This position is housed within Social Science and reports to the Vice President for Transfer Education and Student Success with immediate supervision under the Lead Faculty for Social Science/Education.

Job responsibilities include, but are not limited to: Teaching 15 credit hours of Criminal Justice/Sociology classes per semester; advising and coaching students; developing and monitoring internships; serving on college committees; engaging in CJ recruitment activities; working a minimum of 35 hours per week; maintain course records and assessment data; fulfilling other duties as assigned. Some off-campus, night, and/or weekend instruction may be required. Summer teaching is optional.

Qualifications: A master's degree in Sociology (with an emphasis in criminal justice),

Criminal Justice, or Criminology is required. A minimum of eighteen graduate hours in Sociology are required. Both law enforcement or related field experience and previous teaching experience in a higher education, specifically at the community college level, are preferred.

Salary: Commensurate with education and experience.
