

Math Faculty Member Position

East Arkansas Community College is accepting applications for a full-time, nine month faculty position in Mathematics. This faculty position is housed within Math and Science and reports to the Vice President for Transfer Education and Student Success with direct supervision by the Lead Faculty in Math/Science.

Job responsibilities include, but are not limited to: teaching fifteen credit hours of Mathematics Courses per semester and holding office hours for a combined total of thirty-five on campus hours per week; delivering both lecture and online instruction in courses ranging from Algebra through Calculus and Statistics; advising students; serving on college committees; designing curriculum; maintaining course records and assessments; fulfilling other duties as assigned. Some off-campus, night, and/or weekend instruction may be required. Summer teaching is optional.

Qualifications: A master's degree in Math, Math Education or closely related field with eighteen graduate hours in the Mathematics discipline is required; previous teaching experience, both face to-face and online, in higher education, specifically at the community college level, is preferred.

Salary: Commensurate with education and experience.
