POSITION SUMMARY

The Practical Nursing Instructor is responsible for curriculum development, curriculum delivery, clinical supervision, candidate selection for the PN program, assessment, and document preparation.

TYPICAL FUNCTIONS

Instruct students in theory aspects of the nursing curriculum, give individual instruction as needed, complete records as recommended/required by East Arkansas Community College and the Arkansas Board of Nursing, evaluate student progress by grading classroom work and observing skills demonstrated by the student, prepare lesson plans, arrange class schedules, instruct students in safety procedures to follow in the application of nursing skills, schedule clinical experience rotations to be assigned in affiliating agencies, supervise students in their clinical settings.

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITY, AND SKILLS

Knowledge of subject matter being taught, knowledge of educational planning and teaching techniques, knowledge of learning aids and teaching materials appropriate to the subject matter, ability to develop and teach students based on assessments and evaluation, ability to evaluate progress and revise lesson plans as needed.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must have a Bachelor of Nursing Degree and hold a current Arkansas Registered Nursing credential with at least 2 years' experience as a Registered Nurse. Background in instruction will be given preference. Preference will be given to applicants with a variety of experience i.e. clinic, hospital, long-term care, etc.
