Purpose

This scholarship was established in May of 1998 and is funded through contributions from the faculty and staff of the Forrest City School District and the Forrest City Education Foundation.

The purpose of this scholarship is twofold: (1) It is to assist students who are attending college and are planning to major in Teacher Education; and (2) it is to retain

our college graduates. Upon receiving a teaching degree and becoming certified to teach, the recipient is required to teach full-time in the Forrest City School District for a minimum of one year to receive full forgiveness of the scholarship/loan.



Forrest City Education Foundation Teacher Scholarship Application

QUALIFICATIONS:

- The applicant must be a graduate of a St. Francis County high school or attended a St. Francis County high school and subsequently received a GED; or the applicant may be a graduate of East Arkansas Community College.
- Must be a full-time college student, has completed at least 60 semester hours, and has at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
- Must provide a 300 word essay on "Why I Want to Teach".
- Must provide a letter of recommendation from one instructor in their major field.
- The recipient must maintain a GPA of at least 2.5.
- After graduation, the recipient is required to teach full-time in the Forrest City School District for a minimum of one year to receive full forgiveness of the scholarship/loan.

AWARD PROCEDURES:

- The scholarship committee will meet to review the applications. A selection of the top two applicants will be made based on the guidelines for the scholarship criteria. The candidates will then be contacted for an interview.
- The committee will meet to select the scholarship recipient and will announce the winner. The committee will contact the recipient and set a date for a press release and officially award the scholarship.
- The award amount is \$3,000.00 for an academic year.
