



STEPS FOR GETTING ENROLLED INTO THE GED® PROGRAM

❖ 18 and older

- a. Must be an Arkansas Resident
- b. Must be over 18 (Under 18 has different requirements)
- c. Arkansas Photo ID and Social Security Card
- d. Take TABE Test

❖ 16- and 17-year-olds

- a. Must be an Arkansas Resident
- b. Arkansas Photo ID and Social Security Card
- c. Obtain waiver/release form from last school attended (copy of form can be obtained from Adult Education Secretary at EACC)
- d. If student is homeschooled, documentation stating the student is/was being homeschooled.
- e. Take TABE Test (Level D) at EACC
 - i. Must score 535 or higher on each area of Reading, Math, and Language on the TABE Test (Level D)
- f. Must be accompanied by an adult guardian when visiting the EACC GED Director

After TABE testing:

- ❖ Orientation and Class Assignment with office staff
- ❖ Classroom academic goals set with instructor
- ❖ Periodic TABE testing for academic progress

**TABE test is given Monday and Wednesday morning at 8:00 am.
Must be on time!**
