

## Diesel Service Technology Instructor

### POSITION SUMMARY

The Diesel Service Technology Instructor is responsible for preparing materials as necessary to instruct, manage, and supervise individuals and groups in classrooms and laboratories through demonstration, discussion, use of visual aids, etc. The instructor is responsible for the good order and safety of the labs, classrooms, and associated areas.

### TYPICAL FUNCTIONS

Assess instruction and learning by means of written, oral, practical, surveys, and performance testing. Maintain a student-oriented approach to education. Maintain and submit accurate and current reports and records involving student accountability, attendance, and performance. Serve on committees and attend faculty and other meetings as assigned. Maintain the labs and service bay areas to the highest industry standards. Assist in student recruitment and events. Improve professionally, obtain and maintain certifications as required. Stay current on new and developing technologies and techniques in the diesel service industry. Develop and revise curriculum as needed.

### KNOWLEDGE, ABILITY, AND SKILLS

Knowledge of the principles and practices of the vocational education program. Knowledge of the functions, operations, and/or maintenance of the various equipment used in a diesel service program. Ability to instruct students in a vocational education program. Ability to evaluate student performance and measure progress. Ability to revise curriculum. Must demonstrate strong written and oral communication skills.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- A certificate in Diesel Service Technology or equivalent experience and training
- 2 years of work experience in transportation field/industry
- Valid AR Driver's license (CDL/A preferred)
- Experience/Training on gasoline engines a plus

- Direct experience as a Diesel Technician
- Class A CDL License
- ASE Certified Master Medium-Heavy Truck Technicians (Successful applicant must attain an ASE Medium-Heavy Truck Technician Master Certification within 2 years of employment.)
- Teaching and/or training background
