

Full-Time Instructor of Psychology:

Position Summary: The primary responsibility of the position is the teaching of psychology courses. Other job responsibilities include, but are not limited to: managing an advising caseload; institutional committee assignments; working a minimum of 35 hours per week; maintaining course records, which includes course assessment; engaging in appropriated professional development activities; fulfilling other duties as assigned. Some off-campus and/or evening instruction may be required. Summer teaching is optional.

Minimum Qualifications: A Master's degree in Psychology or a closely related field with 18 graduate semester hours in Psychology. An ideal candidate will possess: interest in and commitment to community college education; excellent written and interpersonal communication skills; ability and willingness to work effectively within the Humanities academic department; willingness to actively participate in college committees and campus organizations; seek active involvement in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Preferred Qualifications: Two or more years of experience teaching in higher education; proven experience with and understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, disability, and ethnic backgrounds of working, commuting, and other non-traditional community college students.
