

Medical Professions Education Instructor

East Arkansas Community College is seeking a Medical Professions Education Instructor that will provide instruction at EACC's Secondary Career Center in Wynne, AR. This position will work a 10.5 month annual contract, with a 35-40 hour per week workload consisting of lecture/classroom time and clinical time: some weekend work may be required upon the scheduling of clinicals. EACC offers all full-time employees a generous benefits package including employer paid health and dental insurance, a retirement match of 14%- 15.32% and generous leave time.

POSITION SUMMARY

The instructor will be responsible for preparing tests, class projects and case studies; grading papers, averaging. Also will prepare lesson plans, lectures, and assist with development and implementation of course syllabus and curriculum. Instructor will use the Arkansas Office of Long Term care Curriculum to prepare nurse aide students to successfully complete the hands-on portion of the nurse aide certification exam. This position requires the instructor to teach on campus in the Nurse Aide lab and on-site at the long-term care facilities affiliated with the campus course.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

A minimum of an Associate Degree in Nursing is required; must have a current unencumbered registered nurse (RN) license to practice in Arkansas with at least two years of clinical experience and/or education experience. One year experience in a long term care or home health is preferred. A background check and drug screen are required.
