

## Heavy Equipment Operator Instructor

### **Typical Functions:**

The full-time Heavy Equipment Operator Instructor is a 10.5 month faculty position. Perform teaching activities including classroom instruction, classroom management, and grade submission. Prepare and implement teaching and evaluation strategies for Heavy Equipment Operator students in the classroom as well as in field settings. Participate in development, planning, implementation, and evaluation of Heavy Equipment Operator curriculum. The individual must maintain professional standards of practice in teaching in the classroom and in field settings. Perform other duties and services for the college and department as assigned by the Dean of Vocational, Occupational, and Technical Education and EACC Administration.

### **Minimum Qualification:**

Associates Degree (preferred); five or more years of experience with heavy commercial equipment-heavy duty vehicles designed for construction tasks such as earth moving, grading and surveying. Current CDL license is required. Survey experience including experience with grade stakes. Must be able to drive a standard transmission. Must be familiar with Heavy Equipment preventative maintenance and service. Candidate should be familiar with NCCER certifications.
