Typical Functions:

The selected candidate will prepare materials as necessary to instruct, manage, and supervise individuals and groups in the classrooms and laboratories through demonstration, discussion, visual aids, conferences, etc. This instructor assesses instruction and learning by means of written, oral, practical and performance tests and maintains a student-oriented approach to education. Maintains and submits accurate and current reports and records involving student accountability, attendance, and performance. Improves professionally and maintains currency through maintaining certification as required; participating in professional and specialty courses; and keeping abreast of new developments, trends, and techniques. Develops and revises curriculum as needed. Performs other duties as assigned. This position will be assigned to the Federal Correctional facility located in Forrest City, AR. This is a grant funded position.

Minimum Qualifications:

A Certificate in Diesel Service Technology or equivalent (successful applicant must attain an ASE Medium-Heavy Truck Technician Certification within two years of employment); experience as a trainer/instructor, 3 years of work experience as a diesel technician. A valid Arkansas Driver's License.

Preferred Qualifications:

Associates Degree; ASE Certified Master Medium-Heavy Truck Technician. CDL License.
