#### **Position Summary:**

The EMT/Paramedic Instructor is responsible for preparing and implementing teaching and evaluation strategies for EMS students in the classroom as well as in clinical settings.

#### **Typical Functions:**

The full time EMS Instructor Faculty is a 10.5 month faculty position. The individual must be able to teach didactic and clinical components. Perform teaching activities including classroom instruction, classroom management, and grade submission. Prepare and implement teaching and evaluation strategies for EMS students in the classroom as well as in clinical settings. Participate in development, planning, implementation, and evaluation of EMS curriculum. The individual must maintain professional standards of practice in teaching in the classroom and in clinical settings. Perform other duties and services for the College and Department as assigned by the Dean of Nursing and Allied Health and EACC Administration.

#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

A minimum of an Arkansas EMS Instructor License at EMT level (Paramedic Level preferred); Associate's Degree or Bachelor's Degree preferred; Nationally Registered Paramedic with current Arkansas license; Must have a minimum (2) years EMS experience; BLS Instructor credentials and ACLS Instructor credentials preferred.

Salary Range: \$45,000 annual (\$27.95/hr) - \$51,667 annual (\$32.09/hr) based on experience/no degree; \$47,222 annual (\$29.33/hr) - \$53,089 annual (\$32.97/hr) with Associate's degree.
